Clearance Authorities

Port Control is responsible for organizing the clearance authorities to come down to the marina. Please contact Port Control on channel 16 regularly for an update.

Clearance Authorities consist of:

- 1. Health Department
- 2. Customs
- 3. Quarantine
- 4. Immigration (You maybe required to go to the immigration office in town last with all documents)

Health & Customs Department prohibit any persons to exit the marina or have any visitors onboard their vessel until clearances have been done.

Vessels on anchor will need to pick up the clearance authorities on their dingy to do clearances onboard.

Marina Gate

The gate will be locked for security purposes at night and opened during the day.

Each vessel using the marina will be issued a key with a replacement fee of \$20 tala if key is lost.

Please keep gate locked to stop any unwanted visitors on the Marina.

Vessels on anchor and using the dingy dock will be required to pay a deposit of \$20 tala for keys to access the marina. This will be refunded upon return of keys.

Marina Office

The Marina office is located on the western side of the marina next to the Game Fishing club.

If unattended, please see contact information.

Payments

We currently do not have a credit card facility so all payments are in cash in local currency.

We realize sailing plans change all the time due to weather conditions so all payments are settled at the end of stay preferably one day before departure. Vessels planning to depart on the weekend to please pay on Friday.

All payments can be worked out beforehand from rate sheet attached and there are no hidden costs.

Clearing Out

Customs now require a receipt from the marina before they will issue final clearance papers.

Electricity Charges (Effective 1st October 2017)

Vessels On Anchor

1. Vessels must seek permission from Port Master to anchor in the harbour.
3. Vessels on anchor are required to pay \$50 per week or part thereof for the use of the marina to access shore. This includes the use of the dingy dock, bathroom/showers and security for your vessel.
4. Alternative shore access includes main beach in front of Sheraton Hotel or dingy dock behind main wharf.
