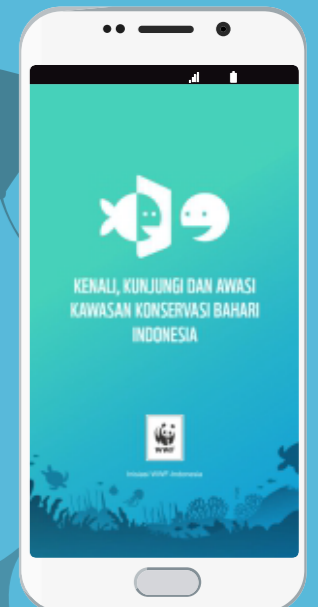

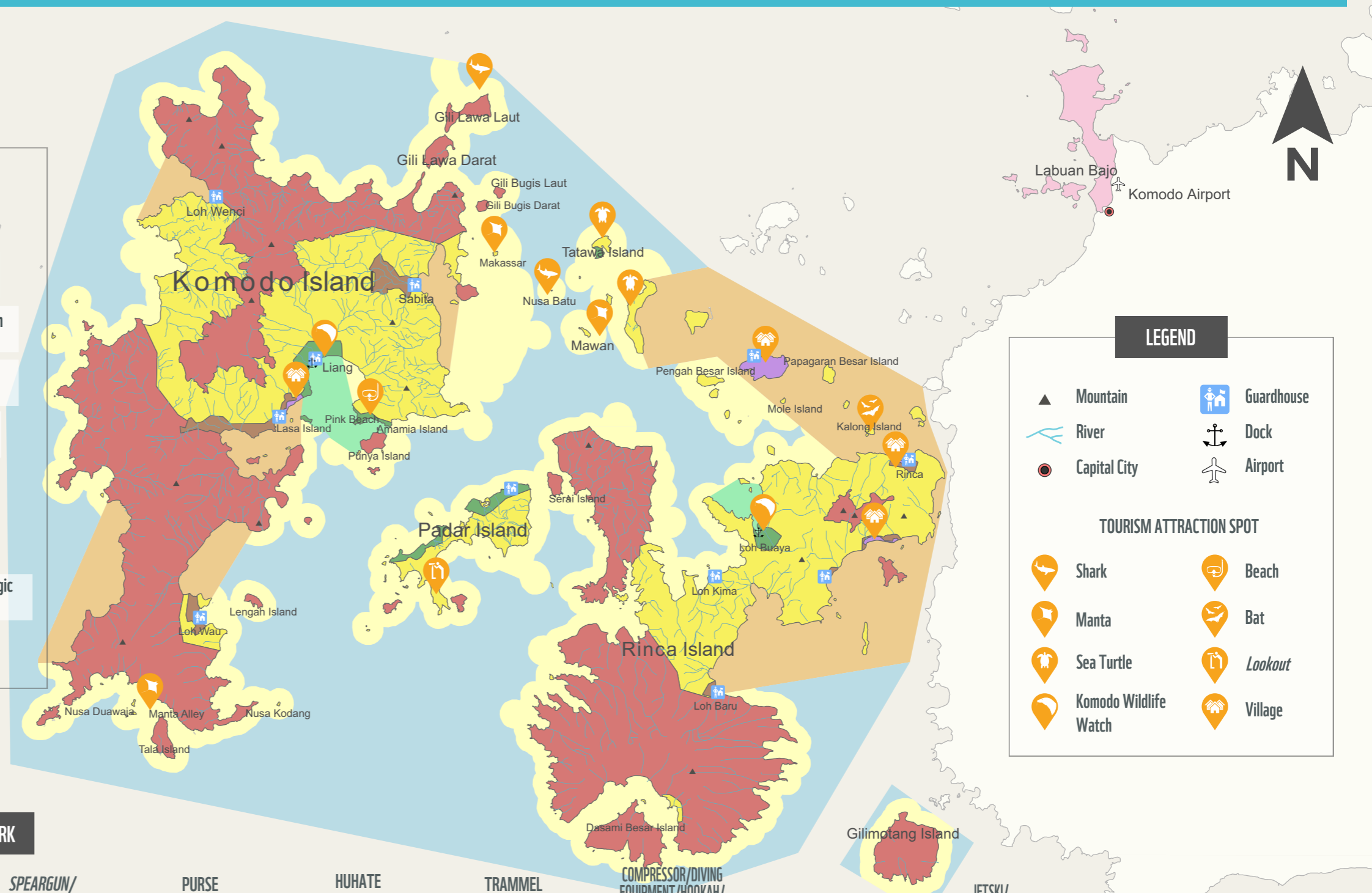

KOMODO NATIONAL PARK ZONING INFORMATION

CORE ZONE	Absolute protection zone without human activity, except education and research
JUNGLE ZONE	Mainland protection zone, only for limited natural tourism, education and research
MARINE PROTECTION ZONE	Marine protection zone for limited natural tourism, education and research. Taking everything from the sea is forbidden.
MAINLAND TOURISM UTILIZATION ZONE	Mainland zone for center of development of terrestrial tourism
MARINE TOURISM UTILIZATION ZONE	Marine zone for center of development of marine tourism
TRADITIONAL LAND UTILIZATION ZONE	Mainland zone that is utilized for the basic needs of native inhabitants of the region
TRADITIONAL MARINE UTILIZATION ZONE	Marine zone that is utilized for the basic needs of the native inhabitants of the region
UTILIZATION ZONE SPECIAL FOR PELAGIC	Marine zone for fishing of the traditionally unprotected pelagic species and recreational fishery
ZONE SPECIAL FOR TRADITIONAL COMMUNITY SETTLEMENT	Zone where the native inhabitants live
